All have sinned These three words strike a fatal blow to the " and them" mentality. I need to stop pointing my finger at the Putin's of this world and turn it back to myself, for All have sinned, and that includes me. I have found myself, more often than not, building my empire, seeking my ambitions, satisfying my desires.
All the things I say I do for Christ will prove to be if the motivation of my heart is not right! People may still benefit by my actions, but ultimately, my actions will have no impact on proclaiming the Kingdom of God in our midst.
Rising from the ashes of his seeming failure he to know nothing among [the Corinthians] except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified. To know nothing but Christ, and Him crucified is a decision we make! It just doesn't happen! Paul's decision to know only Christ arose from reflecting on his life experience.
Here's the secret of learning, the Holy Spirit and God's Word combined withon our experience!
let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give to your Father in heaven. That takes wisdom! Every choice we make falls on the side of the wisdom of this world or the wisdom of God! Believers and unbelievers alike can "hit or miss" when it comes to the wisdom of God! But we don't have to "hit or miss"; there is a sure path to the wisdom of God, Jesus Christ, Himself.
