Judges 4:1-7 "At That Time, Deborah was Judging Israel:

Here we are again.

Victory of Joshua over Jabin of Hazor a hundred years ago. (Joshua 11:1-11) Jabin (may be a title like 'Pharaoh') of Hazor oppressed Israel. (Judges 4:2)

Cause of trouble: Israel did what was evil in the sight of the LORD after Ehud died. Where is God? God allowed them to come under the oppression of King Jabin. The latest military hardware: 900 iron chariots.

How long did God allow this oppression? Until they cried out to God. (20 years)

Where do these leaders like Deborah and Samuel come from?

Structures of the institution.

God calling people who are within or outside the structures of power.

What was the work of Deborah in this text?

Prophet listens to the LORD, the God of Israel and speaks only that to the people. **Judge** directs decisions in tricky legal, moral, ethical, spiritual situations.

(In the New Testament: 1 Cor 5:11,12; 6:1-7

Church needs to work through internal conflicts. God will judge those outside the church.)

Directs other leaders of God's people, including military leaders. Judges 4:6.

Takes responsibility for movement of the enemy because it revealed by God. Judges 4:7

Declares the fulfillment of God's purposes even if it seems unlikely. Judges 4:7

Forty years of rest and disappears from history. Judges 5:31 Israel still disordered.

Who has God sent to do this work in Christ's Community Church?

How can God's work in a community of faith be recognized and followed?

What work has God called you to do in the congregation?

How can the focus be on what God is doing in the Kingdom of God and not on leaders per se?
