"What Kind of Baptism Did You Receive?"

Focus Verse: Acts 19:3

I. PAST

As a new year begins, examine our hearts and assess our past experiences.

John's Baptism: Repentance from sins

Baptism in the name of Jesus: Repentance, Faith and the Holy Spirit

II. PRESENT REALITY The teaching of Scripture

- A. Jesus was baptized by John but did not baptize (Jn 4:2)
- B. Earliest Christian writings **assume** baptism without explaining (Acts, Paul, John, non-Canonical writers)
- C. John's baptism + Jesus's death and resurrection
- D. Some of the clearest teachings on baptism:

Romans 6:3,4 Colossians 2:12 Go into the water means **death** with Christ, coming out means **resurrection** with Christ.

Galatians 3:27 To clothe yourself with Christ

Romans 4:11 **Seal** of the righteousness received by faith.

I Corinthians 6:11 **Washed, sanctified, justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God.

I Peter 1: 2 Sprinkled with Christ's blood, as an OT temple sacrifice would have been.

Ephesians 4:4-6 **Demonstration of unity** in Christ, one body, one Spirit, one baptism.

Acts 2:38, 39 Forgiveness of sins and reception of the Holy Spirit in **fulfillment of the covenant** made by God with Israel and by extension those who believe.

Romans 10:9 Confess with your mouth, believe in your heart. Public confession of faith.

III. FUTURE

- A. How far do you plan to let your involvement with Christ to go?
- B. Is there a gap between what you expected out of your experience with God and what you are actually experiencing?
 - Waiting for someone like Paul to ask us whether we have received the Holy Spirit.
 - 2. Ask God to show us all that we have received in Christ.
 - 3. Be dazzled by what appear to be the spectacular gifts of the Holy Spirit of a leader and desire those over the fruit of the Holy Spirit (*Galatians 5:22, 23*)
 - 4. Reject the work of the Holy Spirit and only focus on living a sober, Godly life.
