Jesus goes village to village: Mark 6:6 b; Matthew 9:35-18, 10:1, 20-24; Luke 8:1-4ff

Jesus sends the Twelve out village to village: Mark 6:7-13, 30-44; Matthew 10:1-42; Luke 9:1-17

Jesus sends the 70/72 out village to village: Luke 10:1-24

Resurrected Jesus sends eleven disciples to make disciples in every nation: Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-18 (Not believed to be original ending); Luke 24:45-48

Have you ever given hospitality in Christ's name? What was that like for you?

When the Gospel came to you, were there other benefits given to you along with the Message?

Would you offer the Good News without something else, like food, water, clothes? *James 2:17-26, Matthew 25:31-46* 

If you had nothing to offer except the Gospel, would you have courage and faith to give what you had as of incalculable value and be willing to accept whatever hospitality was given?

In what way is it hard for the rich to enter the kingdom of heaven? Matthew 19:19,20 (16-30)
