After many stories about Jesus' healing and teaching in the first half of the Gospel of Mark, the second half turns with Jesus telling his disciples three time what will happen to him.

Identifies himself as the Son of Man.

Will be condemned by people pledged to the Law of God.

Will be suffer death.

Will rise again in three days.

Mark 8:31; Mark 9:31; Mark 10:33-34

What kind of healing and deliverance are we seeking for ourselves and for those we love? Is there anything wrong with wanting to be happy?

How might the work of Christ be different from and better than what we would like?

What does it mean for us to take up our cross and follow Jesus (as we sing)? Mark 8:34-37
